RESOLUTION OF REDLANDS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT REGARDING SOUTH COAST AIR QUALITY
MANAGEMENT DISTRICT LOWER-EMISSION SCHOOL BUS PROGRAM

It was approved by the Redlands Unified School District Governing Board that the following Resolution be adopted:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING JUAN J. CABRAL TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR AND TO SIGN CERTAIN ASSURANCES WITH RESPECT TO APPLICATIONS FOR LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL PROGRAMS, PROJECTS OR GRANTS

WHEREAS, Several Local, State and Federal programs allow public and non-profit transportation providers to apply for administration, capital, and operation assistance programs or grants; and

WHEREAS, the Redlands Unified School District Governing Board must authorize someone by resolution, as the "Authorized Individual" to make application and administer South Coast Air Quality Management District Lower-Emission School Bus Program grant funds; and

WHEREAS, any purchase or expenditure associated with the grant application will be contingent on the Redlands Unified School District being awarded the necessary grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Redlands Unified School District Governing Board hereby authorizes Juan J. Cabral to make application for, to sign required assurances, and to administer the South Coast Air Quality Management District Lower-Emission School Bus Program grant funds with respect to applications for Local, State and Federal programs, projects or grants, on behalf of the Redlands Unified School District;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any purchases or commitments made by the Redlands Unified School District related to this grant application shall be contingent upon the Redlands Unified School District being awarded sufficient grant funding.
