ACTION ITEM

Approve 2024-2025 Comprehensive School Safety Plans (CSSP) for the following school sites: Arroyo Verde Elementary; Crafton Elementary; Cram Elementary; Franklin Elementary; Highland Grove Elementary; Judson & Brown Elementary; Kimberly Elementary; Kingsbury Elementary; Lugonia Elementary; McKinley Elementary; Mentone Elementary; Mission Elementary; Smiley Elementary; Victoria Elementary; Beattie Middle School; Clement Middle School; Moore Middle School; Citrus Valley High School; Redlands East Valley High School; Redlands Senior High School; and eAcademy (Appendix Item).

AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION

California Education Code (EC) Section 32281(a) requires every kindergarten through grade twelve school, public and public charter, including community and court schools, to develop and maintain a CSSP designed to address campus risks, prepare for emergencies, and create a safe, secure learning environment for students and school personnel.

The law requires designated stakeholders to annually engage in a systematic planning process to develop strategies and policies to prevent and respond to potential incidents involving emergencies, natural and other disasters, hate crimes, violence, active assailants/intruders, bullying and cyberbullying, discrimination and harassment, child abuse and neglect, discipline, suspension and expulsion, and other safety aspects.

The law requires that each school update and adopt its CSSP by March 1 annually. It requires that the school district or COE approve CSSPs. EC does not specify a date by which the safety plan must be approved by the district; however, the school district or COE must annually notify the CDE by October 15 of any school(s) that have not complied with

requirements.

Effective school safety planning must be a dynamic, ongoing process with plans being reviewed and evaluated regularly, and after critical incidents.
