1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

The Redlands Unified School District began receiving AMS funds in February 2024. The Purchasing window and New Position window closed on March 5, 2024, thus, the 2023-2024 AMS funds were not spent. Instead, time was used on educating the community, families, and school staff on the purpose of AMS funding and guidelines for spending. An online community survey was distributed from November 6, 2023 - November 12, 2023, and was available to all families, teachers, and staff, as well as secondary students. A total of 1,128 participants completed the survey. From that information, all schools receiving AMS funding began their planning. Each school worked with their School Site Councils to approve their AMS Plans in May 2024 or June 2024.
